











The River

Parana river with a 1.000.000 square miles watershed and more than 3000 miles long, is the second biggest watercourse in south America. Only overcome by the Amazonas river, starting in Brazil then Paraguay ending in Argentina, flowing into the River Plate delta. It's massive water flow transports great amount of sediments which makes it a dynamic system, changing it's form constantly creating new banks, sandbars, islands, smaller side-streams, deltas, and dragging logs where the Dorado loves to hide.

You can fish almost year-round except for December. "The Tiger of the River", as locals call the Dorado, concentrates the major migration volume from June to November feeding from the Sabalo inflow.

Bella Vista town is located in Corrientes province and it is nowadays one of the best spots for Dorado fishing. A unique location where the river offers the best conditions and the clearest water flow available as a consequence of recent year's transformations and water levels fluctuation.



The Fishing

Our team of professional guides will provide you the best experience in Dorado fly-fishing and bait-cast fishing. All of our guides are experienced anglers with tons of hours chasing the big Tigers in the area. The team will boost your chances to challenge the aggressive Dorado, you will be well prepared for their super strong takes, their power jumps and tough fights taking any angler to the next level.









Acommodations

The accommodations for our programs consists in one of the best hotels of Bella Vista town. Located in the riverside meters away from the boats dock, this Posada offers excellent services.

Lunch will be served during your fishing day in the river, our guides will delight you with great meals on the shore or sand banks.

Logistics to get to Bella Vista is simple; there are daily flights connecting Buenos Aires Aeroparque Domestic Airport (AEP) to Corrientes (CNQ) or Resistencia (RES). It is a 1-hour nonstop flight to either of these airports, then our host will drive you 80 miles to the hotel.








Fish and Tackle

"The Tiger of the River" will be our main target during our fishing sessions as also great chances for Pacu and Pira Pita depending on the time of the year. These last two are great fish to catch with a fly rod using a pattern that imitates the small fruits they eat on the sides of the river. Clear waters and sand banks on our area gives good chances of sight-fishing while they cruise the banks like sharks.

- Fly fishing tackle: 7 to 9 weight Rods for Dorado and Pacú and 5 to 6 weight for Pira Pitá. Floating lines for warm weather. Streamers will be the main fly to cast, some poppers and fruits for Pira Pita and Pacú.
- Bait cast tackle: Mid weigh rods (15-30lb) gear will be ideal to let you cast all day and enjoy the fierce fight of the Dorado. We will provide a list of lures that work great for our rivers.





Catch & Release Programs

Rates

Payment Terms:

A 50% deposit is required to reserve your requested fishing dates. The deposit is not refundable. Full payment is due 60 days in advance of your scheduled trip. For all cancellations made more than 60 days prior to trip: the initial 50% deposit is non-refundable but it can be applied for future trips. If the trip was paid in full, the total amount

can be applied for a future trip.

For all "no show" or cancellations made less than 60 days prior to the fishing trip: full payment of the program will be deducted and is not refundable. The acceptable methods of payment after arrival are cash or personal checks ONLY. A 4% surcharge will be applied on foreign personal checks (surcharge by local banks).
